MOVE UPs and TRANSFERS

Class MOVE UPs and Transfers prior to Saturday and Sunday Trials will be accepted until 8:00 AM CDT on Thursday, September 19, 2024.

SATURDAY ONLY SAME DAY class MOVE UPs are allowed between all levels of INTERIORS and BURIED (No move-ups to Interior Masters Level).

SUNDAY ONLY SAME DAY class MOVE UPs are allowed between all levels of EXTERIORS and CONTAINERS.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

ENTRY FEES

Each entry per dog per day*......\$25 MASTER Level Entry per dog per day......\$30 *an entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class. Entry fees include a \$3,50 per run AKC recording fee.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Checks returned for insufficient funds will invalidate the entry; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, including a \$25 collection fee, are paid via certified check, money order, or cash, and received prior to the closing date.

Entry receipts and final confirmations will be sent by email to exhibitors who include email addresses on their entry forms. MAKC is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries that do not include exhibitor email addresses will receive only final confirmations by USPS mail after closing.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

MAKC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **75 entries per trial** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **SEPTEMBER 12, 2024 at 6:00 PM CDT**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on SEPTEMBER 12, 2024 at 6:00 PM CDT. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund or check will be shredded.

SEARCH AREAS AND CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and will be the size(s) required in the *Regulations for AKC Scent Work*. **Search Area Conditions for these trials** may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, concrete, dirt surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, asphalt or matted surfaces. Indoor areas have been used for exhibitions only. <u>No animals have been housed in any of the search areas</u>.

Search areas will be accessed on concrete, black top, gravel or dirt walkways from parking lots. There will be no stairs, but may be elevated threshholds. There may be bleachers in the search area.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include indoor and outdoor warm-up and waiting areas, and may include the Trial Secretary's table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

At the Judge's discretion, a **Handler's Briefing** may be held prior to the start of the judging day or before a class begins, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. During the Handler's Briefing, the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **warm-up area** will be designated by the Event Committee. One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Crating space will be available only to the Judge, the Trial Chair, the Trial Secretary and members of the Event Committee. **Additional crating space may be available to volunteers.** All crating for other trial participants must be done from your vehicle. **MAKC** and the **Marshfield Fairgrounds** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). <u>Any exhibitor failing to do so may be</u> <u>excused without benefit of refund</u> if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the grounds.

Spectator Area. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Some areas will not be suitable for spectators, as determined by the Judge.

Concessions. Food will not be available for purchase at the trial site. You are welcome to bring a bag lunch to eat in your vehicle. Several restaurants are located near the trial site in Marshfield, WI.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Marshfield Area Kennel Club, The Marshfield Fairgrounds, and the American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Marshfield Area Kennel Club and the American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Marshfield Area Kennel Club or the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times while on the trial grounds. Retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds, except during judged searches. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund unless written notification accompanied by a letter from a licensed veterinarian is received **before** the day of trial or the withdrawn entry is filled with a waitlisted entry.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee only if written notification is received by the Trial Secretary no less that 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN and BRIEFING: Exhibitors will be notified by email once the time and location for check-in and briefing is determined. At check-in, you will receive a sticker with your armband number to wear during the competition.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.


